#### Do I have to pay in advance to reserve my spot?

You must pay the registration fee (non-refundable) of \$100 to reserve your spot.

#### What is included in the camp?

Kicks x Jhericoco will provide you with the following:

- Your personal paint kit, unless you opted out.
- Extra paint colors, vinyls, tools and finishes for class usage.

#### Do you offer lunch?

Students are responsible for bringing their own temperature safe lunches. There is also a food court conveniently on site (permission slip needed to leave during lunch). Kicks x Jhericoco will have basic snacks and water for all students.

#### Do you offer transportation?

Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from the camp site.

#### What experience level is needed for this camp?

No experience is necessary, but all levels are welcomed. During introductions, we will provide all students with suiting assignments for every level.

#### Is there an age requirement?

This specific camp is geared towards students aged 12-18, but we are planning to expand. If you're not within this age range and are interested in learning this craft, please email us at camps@jhericoco.com with your age and request.

#### Do you allow returns/cancellations?
